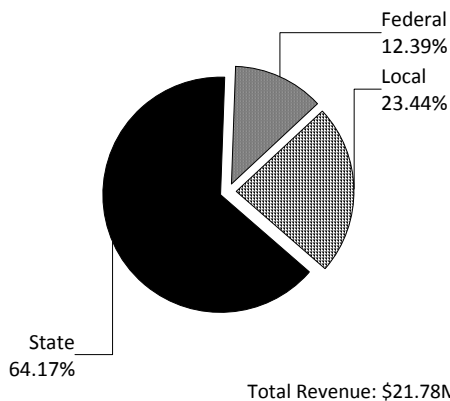

### Revenue Sources



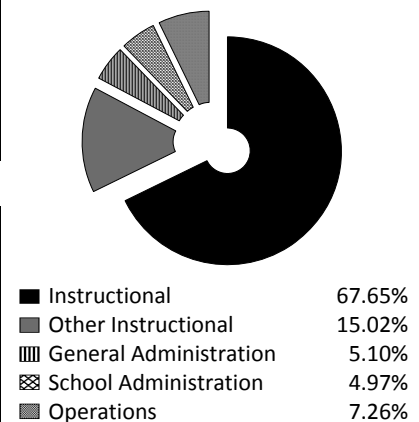
